

#### 1) TRANSIT ORIENTATED COMMUNITIES (TOC's)

TOC's were enacted in September 2017 as a response to Proposition JJJ which will provide developers density bonuses for providing affordable housing that will have a significant impact on our Mid-City neighborhood. Learn how this affects you and our Mid-City neighborhood!

**Featured Presenter: Matt Glesne**, Senior Planner for the City of Los Angeles Planning Department who led the development and drafting of this state initiative to increase housing density along transit corridors for the City of Los Angeles while increasing affordable housing.

#### 2) LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF BUILDING AND SAFETY (LADBS)

Learn about how LADBS addresses the review, code enforcement and inspection process as it relates to TOC's and the effect of construction we have seen come to our neighborhoods.
